Browser extension features include:

Seeking an experienced automations and scripting contractor. We require support to automate both our marketing strategy and our MVP product. We are using several 3rd party SaaS products to achieve these goals. This job will be part time up front for several weeks, and will require ongoing occasional support after the startup period. We are seeking a candidate who has experience with:

- Bank level security
- Client Login/personal account
- Onboarding process where users fill out a form to collect the data to be autofilled
- Profile section where users can view and edit their information
- Detect and autofill forms on websites the user visits
- Track applications previously completed
- Ability to create multiple profiles under one account.
- Develop a backend system to connect with the Chrome extension and host/manage user documents and data strings.
- Familiarity with most of the following platforms: Zapier (or similar), Jotform, Clinked, Hubspot, GSuite, Mighty Networks, Slack, ClickUp.
- Experience with 3rd party API, webhooks
- Experience with iterating MVP products
- Code language desired: React/React Native
- Responsive development experience
- Familiarity with web hosting and DNS records
